Cancellation & Refunds

- Cancellations must be made within 24 hours of scheduled program.
- Weather-related cancellations may be rescheduled based on availability.

Admission & Visit

- Schools registered for Guided History Adventure programs should check in at the gate listed on the reservation contract.
- Scheduled groups will be provided a picnic area for a 30-minute lunch. Playground is available after lunch.
- A minimum of 1 chaperone per 5 students is recommended. All teachers and chaperones are charged \$2 for the Apple Hayride field trips. There is no charge for chaperones for the other guided field trips.
- Participants will be instructed to take shelter at an indoor location or on the bus during inclement weather.
